PRACTICAL INFORMATION	
French courses	The department of French as a Foreign Language (DEFLE Département d'Etude du Français Langue Étrangère) offers <u>courses</u> for non-native French speakers. The courses available will depend on the field of study where the student has been nominated.
Housing	For <u>students with low income</u> , there is a number of spots reserved in some social residences from <u>CROUS</u> (mostly outside Campus). To apply the students will have access to an application form after they have been accepted. Note: the students cannot choose their residence, rooms are allocated by the CROUS according to availability.
	For <u>students with medium income</u> , our partners <u>Studapart</u> offer a lot of different housing possibilities (apartment-sharing, private residences, private apartment, etc.). Their adverts are reserved for students of the university Toulouse Jean Jaurès, their platform is secure and they offer excellent customer service and support for students.
	For <u>student with medium/higher income</u> , the University of Toulouse propose paying packs and services adapted to students' needs: the <u>Toul'box</u> . In addition to personalized support in finding accommodation, the Toul'box team offers a range of basic services for the students to save precious time and start their stay in Toulouse with tranquility (personalized appointment, delivery of a transportation card, assistance in opening a bank account, etc.) These services can also be booked directly by sending universities.
	According to their situations, students can apply to the CAF (Caisse d'Allocations Familiales) for <u>housing benefits</u> .
Health and Medical insurance	<u>European students</u> need to apply for a European Health Insurance Card from the relevant body in their country of origin.
	<u>Non-European students</u> need to register at the " <u>Sécurité Sociale</u> " (free and online).
	There is a health service on Mirail campus (Toulouse), <u>SIMPSS</u> , which offers free consultations by appointment (general practitioners, social workers, nurses, psychologists)
	Students with special needs who benefit from special arrangements at their home university may benefit from the same arrangements at the Université Toulouse Jean Jaurès – IUT Blagnac, if these arrangements also exist at our institution. To do so, they must present an official document from their home university.
Visa and immigration	It is the students' responsibility to <u>get informed and apply for a visa</u> at the French embassy/consulate of their home country. According to students' nationality, they might also need to register first to <u>Etudes en France platform</u> .
Cost of living	Average monthly budget for a student in Toulouse is around 973€ (housing, transport, food, etc.).
